Mitsubishi Electric honored with NRW.INVEST AWARD

On July 4, 2016 Mitsubishi Electric was awarded the NRW.INVEST AWARD in recognition of their significant investment in the North Rhine Westphalia area. The award is representative of all those who have chosen to invest in the region and was presented by the NRW Ministry for Economics and the state economic development agency 'NRW.INVEST'

Mitsubishi Electric recently completed a new state-of-the-art German headquarter in Ratingen-Ost which provides ample space (16,000m²) for 750 employees over five and a half floors, as well as providing generous exhibition space. In choosing the location for the office building Mitsubishi Electric considered the attractiveness of North Rhine Westphalia as a business location, and the significant contribution it would make to the region by constructing the new building there.

The planning and construction of the new building was largely focused on achieving a good energy footprint, which Mitsubishi Electric was able to achieve through the careful use of resources, in part thanks to technology from the company's own products. From installing its own air conditioning and heating solutions, to employing automation technology to manage energy within the building, Mitsubishi Electric was able to prove the concept of sustainable technology and re-inforce it's message about consideration for the environment.

One impressive element of the new building's interior is the innovative "World of Mitsubishi Electric" exhibition space which features eye-catching and interactive displays of products, installations and solutions. The exhibition culminates in a

robotic installation which demonstrates the adaptability of Mitsubishi Electric's automation products via an impressive and light-hearted routine. This robotic installation was awarded both the 'FWA' (Favourite Website Award) and 'Adobe Cutting Edge award' in May 2016, and along with the entire exhibition has been nominated for the 'German Design Award'.

By building its largest European branch office in North Rhine Westphalia area, Mitsubishi Electric is giving a clear signal as to its continued commitment to the region.
