Who has the best idea about Society 5.0? And who convinces with their business plan and secures one of the coveted three winning places? All these questions will be answered at the award ceremony on 7 July 2019 during the Cromford Park Festival.

Today was the starting signal for the school competition, which is jointly organized by "Friends and Sponsors of Cromford Industrial Museum e.V." and Mitsubishi Electric Europe B.V. The participating teams from five schools in Ratingen, Düsseldorf, Heiligenhaus and Essen together with their supervising teachers visited Mitsubishi Electric in Ratingen for an entire day and received interesting information about changes.AWARD.
